





Panthers Background and History

Panthers fall season, which works differently than other seasons and clubs, was started when Chesterfield and surrounding counties did not offer middle school field hockey.

Since there is High School Field hockey it didn't make sense for the Varsity and JV programs to have girls at their tryouts who were all beginners.

What started out as one team in 2005 has now grown to four full middle school teams, plus U10 and Elementary school and a Recreational league.

The league is important to us because we want to grow the game in the RVA area. Finding middle schoolers who want to learn the game together gets them used to playing with one another before they head to High School together. It is our hope

that Varsity programs have girls who already have field hockey knowledge attend their tryouts each August. While we are co- sponsored by Chesterfield County and have approval for both Henrico and Chesterfield, it is very hard for us to spread the word to the schools. It is our goal to have school teams that can have 8-10 girls from one middle school play as a team in the rec league. We make it super easy with loaner sticks, coaches and once a week sessions, for two hours. We welcome your help in spreading the word to your daughter's classmates, friends, PE teachers, Principals,
